Diploma Course in Sanskrit (Sanskrit Pramanpatriya)

Sampurnanand Sanskrit University, Varanasi provides Sanskrit Diploma Course (Sanskrit Pramanpatriya) of three years in the department of Sanskrit Vidya. This course is useful for foreign students as well as Indians residing in border areas i.e. Leh-Laddakh (J&K),Lahul-Spriti & Kinnaur (H.P.), Tripura, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland who want to learn basics of Sanskrit Language and Literature. A Student having 10th standard or High School examination certificate can join this course. A foreign student should produce following documents at the time of admission—

1. The study VISA with special reference to study at 'Sampurnanand Sanskrit University'.
2. Medical Certificate declaring HIV blood test Negative.
3. 10th standard pass certificate as an academic qualification alongwith two self attested photocopies of each.

Admission process can be completed from the office of the Sanskrit Vidya Department from July 2014 to 31st August 2014. After the last date of admission, no new admission will be entertained.
